Presentation and Examination of the **Candidates**

(Parents & Godparents) - I present Laila, Kailyn, Mason & Wyatt to receive the Sacrament of Baptism.

(Celebrant) Will you be responsible for seeing that the child you present is brought up in the Christian faith and life?

(Parents And Godparents) I will, with God's help.

(Celebrant) Will you by your prayers and witness help this child to grown into the full stature of Christ.

(Parents And Godparents) I will, with God's help.

(Celebrant) - Do you renounce Satan and all the spiritual forces of wickedness that rebel against God? - I renounce them.

Do you renounce the evil powers of this world which corrupt and destroy the creatures of God? - **I** renounce them.

Do you renounce all sinful desires that draw you from the love of God?

- I renounce them.

Do you turn to Jesus Christ and accept him as your Savior? - I do.

Do you promise to follow and obey him as your Lord? — **I do.**

Will you who witness these vows do all in your power to support these children in his life in Christ? *(Congregation)* We will.

By his death he has destroyed

death, and by his rising to life again he has won for us everlasting life. Therefore we praise you, joining our voices with Angels and Archangels and with all the company of heaven, who for ever sing this hymn to proclaim the glory of your Name:

The Celebrant Holy and gracious Father: In your infinite love you made us for yourself; and, when we had fallen into sin and become subject to evil and death, you, in your mercy, sent Jesus Christ, your only and eternal Son, to share our human nature, to live and die as one of us, to reconcile us to you, the God and Father of all.

He stretched out his arms upon the cross, and offered himself, in obedience to your will, a perfect sacrifice for the whole world.

On the night he was handed over to suffering and death, our Lord Jesus Christ took bread; and when he had given thanks to you, he broke it, and gave it to his disciples, and said, "Take, eat: This is my Body, which is given for you. Do this for the remembrance of me."

After supper he took the cup of wine; and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, and said, "Drink this, all of you: This is my Blood of the new Covenant, which is shed for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins. Whenever you drink it, do this for the remembrance of me."

Sanctify us also that we may faithfully receive this holy Sacrament, and serve you in unity, constancy, and peace; and at the last day bring us with all your saints into the joy of your eternal kingdom.

All this we ask through your Son Jesus Christ. By him, and with him, and in him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit all honor and glory is yours, Almighty Father, now and for ever. **AMEN.**
